COOKIES POLICY

Background

In accordance with the Spanish law that regulates the use of cookies in relation to providing electronic communication services, contained in Real Decree Law 13/2012 of 30th March, we inform you about the cookies used on this website and the reasons for their use. In addition, you are informed that by browsing the Website you are consenting to their use.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a file that is downloaded onto your computer when accessing certain websites. Cookies enable a web page, among other things, to store and recover information about the browsing habits of a user or of their device and, depending on the information they contain and the way in which the device is used, they may make it possible to recognise the user. Cookies are only associated with an anonymous user and their computer or device and do not enable any personal data to be known.

Types of cookies

1.- First party cookies: those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from the domain managed by the editor providing the service is requested by the user.

2.- Third party cookies: sent to the terminal equipment of the user from a device or domain which is not managed by the editor, but by another entity that handles the data obtained through the cookies.

3.- Session cookies: a type of cookie designed to gather and store data whilst the user accesses a web page.

4.- Persistent cookies: a type of cookie in which the data continues to be stored on the terminal and can be accessed and processed by the person responsible for the cookie, during a defined period which can range from a few minutes to a several years.

5.- Analytical cookies: whether handled by us or by third parties, these enable us to quantify the number of users and therefore measure and carry out statistical analysis of the use made of the service offered. Applicable law

Data Protection Officer

The responsible entities do not have a designated Data Protection Officer.

PURPOSE OF THE HANDLING OF PERSONAL DATA

The processing we carry out on your personal data is for the following purposes:

- 1.-To correctly manage our commercial relationship with customers, guaranteeing a correct management of administrative and commercial aspects, logistics and customer services, and reserving the right to carry out the quality surveys that we deem appropriate in the interest of offering you quality products and services.
- 2.-To inform you of new products, services, offers and invitations to events that may be of interest, using any of the physical and electronic means currently available and those that may arise in the future.

Period for which your data is stored

Your personal data will be stored for the duration of the commercial relationship that connects us, in order to manage administrative and commercial matters, logistics, the provision of customer service and quality control aspects. Once this is completed, personal information will be kept, respecting the period of 6 years established by the Commercial Code for mercantile purposes, and the period of 4 years established by General Taxation Law for tax purposes. With regard to the purpose of informing you about new products, services, offers and invitations that may be of interest, the data will be kept until such time as you exercise your right to its deletion. The data may be stored for the time period during which any liability may arise deriving from a relationship or legal obligation or the execution of a contract or application of pre-contractual measures requested by the individual. In this case the data will be blocked, but not deleted.

Automated decisions and profiling We inform you that there are no automated decisions, including profiling.

LEGITIMATION AND DATA COLLECTED

The legal basis for the processing of personal data is the contractual relationship that connects us with our customers, and its intended use is the management of administrative and commercial aspects, logistics, customer services and quality control.

The legal basis for informing you about products and services is the consent you provide freely and specifically. The contracting by the customer of any product or service offered by those responsible for it, whether via the website, physical document or telephone; the provision of consent to receive information about new products, services; or the sending of emails to managers through the accounts made available for that purpose, imply that the user has read and expressly accepted this privacy policy, and that they provide their unequivocal and express consent to the processing of their personal data in accordance with the purposes outlined.

Data categories
